Sir,

Re Robert Goodwin deced.

Robert Goodwin, formerly of Yoxford Suffolk, & afterwards of Hudson's Bay in the service of the Honourable the Hudson's Bay Company in England, who died on the 22nd of June 1805 by his Will gave £500 Consols to his executors upon trust to pay the interest into the hands of the Hudson's Bay Company in London to be equally divided between Caroline, Nancy and Peggy his daughters by Mistigoose an Indian woman, Jenny the daughter of Pucketwanish an Indian woman, and Anne his daughter by Pucketwanish, to be paid in goods out of the Company's warehouse at Albany Factory during their lives, and at their decease the principal was to go to the Testator's son William Adolphus Barmby Goodwin.

I have presented a Petition to the Court by the administrator of William A.B. Goodwin asking for payment to him of the legacy which is now in Court, and Mr. Justice Kay has made an order on my Petition directing an enquiry who is entitled to the fund, and it becomes necessary to ascertain the correct names of Caroline, Nancy, Peggy, Jenny, and Anne the five tenants for life, and as far as possible to prove their deaths.

I write to ask you kindly to tell me if your Books afford any information to whom the money was paid and when it ceased to be paid.

I shall be happy to pay any charges in connection with the enquiry.

In the Codicil dated 22d April 1803 are the following Words  
I give and bequeath to the said John David Towse, John Barmby and Robert Purvis the Exors under my Will the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds L3 Pcent Consds in Trust for the following purposes to pay the Interest thereof being L15 pr annum into the hands of the Hudsons Bay Compy London to be equally divided between Caroline Nancy and Peggy my natural Daughters by Mistigoose an Indian Woman deced, Jenny the Daughter of Pucktwanish an Indian Woman I at present cohabit with and Anne my Daughter by her the said Jenny share and share alike to be paid in Goods out of the Company's Warehouse at Albany Factory during their natural Lives and at their decease the principal to revert to my natural Son William Adolphus Barmby Goodwin the residuary Legatee under my Will.
